Principal Notes

I pray with my classes each day and many of those prayers are idiosyncratic - quotations or observations that we then discuss. The conversation about what we are doing when we pray is my favorite part because I believe that a mature faith is going to require an ability to navigate places where absolute and correct answers are not available - and still we must act.

The framework I share with my students is that prayer usually comes in one of three categories: help; thanks; wow. The first two tend to be pretty recognizable - we need help or we give thanks. Prayers of awe are rarer but one class had a great experience recently when a student submitted to two beautiful photographs for the prayers. This gave us a chance to express awe and wonder at our place in the universe.

Humility is the thing that links all forms of prayers - I hope to practice that this Lenten season.

Academic Matters

Summer Session

School regulations stipulate that any failing grade must be made up in summer school. Students are also required to attend summer school if they meet one of the following criteria: a final grade of F in any class; a grade of D in Algebra 1, Part 1; Algebra 1, Part 2; regular Algebra 1, or Algebra 2. A grade of D in Honors Algebra 1 or Honors Algebra 2 does not result in required summer school. Instead, the student will move out of the honors math program. A grade of D in the first two levels of a world language also reguires remediation in summer school. If a student achieves an extremely low final grade, he may be required to repeat the course the following year depending on individual academic department regulations. DeMatha makes every attempt to remediate failed classes. Please check the website for summer session offerings beginning April 1. Please take the summer school dates into consideration when making vacation plans. Summer school: Tuesday, June 21 -Thursday, July 21. Failure to make up a class in summer school will result in a \$400 fee being assessed in the fall for administrative and scheduling purposes.
